School Uniform

The ADNOC Schools believes a safe and disciplined learning environment is the first requirement of a high performing school. The implementation of school uniforms will help minimize disruptive behavior, promote respect for oneself and others, build school/community spirit, and, more significantly, help to maintain high academic standards. The school leadership also feels that wearing of uniforms by students will help lessen the impact of socioeconomic differences. In addition, it allows for identification of intruders on campus and encourages students to concentrate on learning rather than on what they are wearing.

ADNOC SCHOOLS Uniform Standards:

Shirts: All students are required to wear a white polo or oxford shirt.

No other shirt types or colors are allowed as per ADNOC SCHOOLS' uniform policy.

General Instructions:

Shirts must be in its proper size with no alterations breaching school uniform policy. All uniform shirts must be the appropriate size for each student, be clean, and tidy each day. Tights, form-fitting, baggy or oversized pants and shirts are not permitted. Students wearing uniform shirts deemed to be inappropriately sized or altered will be subject to disciplinary action and will be required to purchase properly sized uniform.

Boys: Are required to wear the school uniform Navy blue colored belted chino style pants. Boys may not wear any other type of pants including jeans of any kind or color. Flat belt with a small buckle is allowed. The length of the pant must be long enough to cover socks or hosiery. Pants are to fit properly, so they are not excessively tight, baggy, oversized, or worn below the waist. Cords, chains, keys, mobile phones, etc. hanging from the belt or pants pockets are not allowed. The uniform shirt properly tucked in with only one open button at the top.

Girls: Are required to wear the school uniform, Navy blue colored chino style pants, long skirts or jumpers over their uniform shirt. Other pant styles including jeans, jeggings, and tights, form-fitting, or slit skirts and see-through are not permitted.

Physical Education (PE) Clothes: The uniform for PE consists of basketball style shorts or loose fitting athletic pants and a white uniform t-shirt. Also provided by Technical Scissors. Sneakers with non-marking soles are for PE classes only.

Footwear: All students may wear normal acceptable color flat-soled, low cut dress shoes or sneakers. Dress shoes, sneakers, socks/hosiery must be worn properly. For safety measures; NO flip-flops, crocs, sneakers, light-up and wheeled shoes are allowed. Only wear soccer shoes for the PE class in PE period

Hair: (All Students) Unconventional, bizarre and eccentric hairstyles or coloring are not permitted.

Girls: with hair that touches the shoulders or longer must have it pulled back at all times for health and safety issues.

Boys: Hair may not be lower than the top of the ears on the side or longer than the top of the collar.

Make up/Nail Polish and Jewellery: are not allowed at any time during school hours.

Sweaters: Students may purchase Navy Blue or specific school colored Crew Neck or V-Neck sweaters to wear with their school uniform.

Jackets or Vests: Students may wear hoodless jackets or vests over their uniform shirt during cooler times of the year.

Non-Compliance Uniform Standards Consequences:

The ADNOC SCHOOLS Campus administration will work diligently to refrain from suspending students from school because of non-compliance with the uniform standards. However, school will exercise its suspension procedures only when all other options are exhausted.

We ask that parents work in partnership with school to ensure all students arrive at school each day, on time and in complete proper uniform.

First Offense: Cautionary phone call by the principal or his/her designee to the parent/guardian to have them come to school and bring the necessary uniform items for their child to be in uniform standards. If the parent or guardian provides the necessary uniform items and the student is in full uniform, he/she will be able to attend classes for the remainder of the school day.

If the parent or guardian is unable to bring the necessary uniform items, the student will remain in-school suspension room for the day and continue to complete class work for their scheduled classes. A letter will be sent home to remind parents that the student is expected to be in full compliance with Uniform Standards the next day.

Second Offense: Detention assigned. Parent/guardian notification procedure noted above will be followed. If the parent is able to bring in the necessary uniform items, so the student is in full compliance, he/she will be allowed to attend classes for the remainder of the day and then serve detention after school. If student is not able to come into full compliance, he/she will remain in the in-house suspension room for the day and then serve detention after school.

Third Offense: Two detentions assigned. Parent/guardian must come to school to meet with the principal or his/her designee to discuss compliance strategies. Until this meeting is held, the student will remain in the in-school suspension room.

Fourth and subsequent Offense: In-school suspension will be assigned as a disciplinary measure for chronic non-compliance with school rules.
